Diversity Abroad is looking for presenters who can share their knowledge and expertise on topics related to leadership in a global society. Our GSLS participants are passionate about making a positive impact in their communities and developing their leadership skills. As a presenter, you will have the opportunity to engage with these bright and motivated students and help them on their path to becoming successful and inclusive leaders.

The Global Student Leadership Summit (GSLS) is the premier leadership conference for students who are interested in further developing skills related to global diversity, equity, and inclusion. This will be the 8th annual GSLS, which attracts dozens of students from colleges and universities nationwide with a simple goal: to develop the skills essential to being a successful and inclusive leader in a global society.

This year's GSLS will be held in-person in conjunction with the Global Inclusion Conference in Chicago, IL from November 1st-November 3rd, 2023. Students will participate in leadership sessions, engage in critical dialogue centered on self-reflection and identity, establish and maintain relationships with like-minded student leaders, and connect with professionals from higher education, the public sphere, and private sector. Participation in the GSLS will strengthen students' leadership skills and develop global competencies including self-awareness, communication, team building, embracing diversity and difference, and more.

Guidelines & Timeline

- Submissions will be accepted through **Friday, June 3, 2023 at 11:59 PM PDT.**
- Each submission requires information about the prospective presenter's biography, experience facilitating or presenting to undergraduate students and young professionals, and other experiences that would make them a good candidate to serve as a presenter or facilitator at GSLS. These questions have character limits specified in the application, which can be saved and revisited before submitting the application. Undergraduate and graduate student presenters are highly encouraged to submit.
- Presenters are encouraged to review the [2022](#), [2021](#) and [2019](#) GSLS Schedules to better understand the sessions and topics likely to be included for GSLS 2023.
- All presenters who are invited to present or facilitate a session are required to register for the Global Inclusion Conference (professionals) or the Global Student Leadership Summit (students) by the early bird deadline and attend the Conference to present their scheduled session. Presenters will receive a 10% discount on early bird pricing.
